Items needed on 990N:

- > Organization's EIN
- > Fiscal year (e.g., July 1, 2019 June 30, 2020)
- > Name of organization
- > Organization's mailing address
- > Name and address of a principal officer
- > Website address (optional)
- > Answer: Has your organization terminated or gone out of business?
- > Answer: Are your gross receipts still normally \$50,000 or less?
